In the circumstances, The Incorporated Council of Legal Education has directed the Registrar of the Council/Principal of Sri Lanka Law College to:

- i. Inform the above said individuals to desist from engaging in the above activities forthwith
- ii. Complain regarding their misconduct to the Supreme Court
